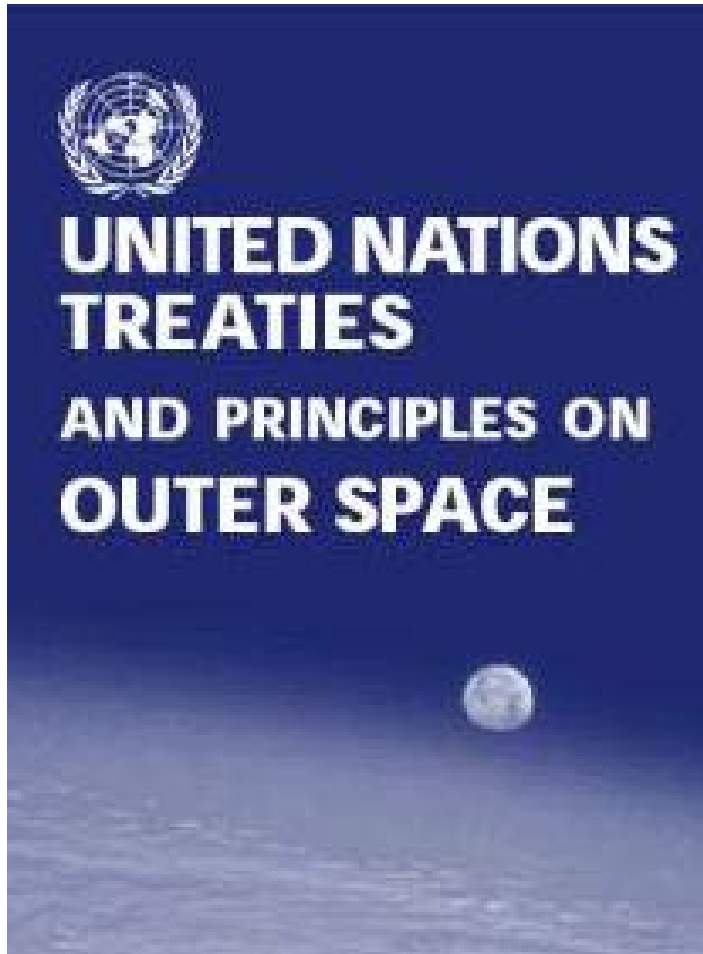
The Aviation and Space Group in the Bundestag

- **Members participate regularly in EISC**

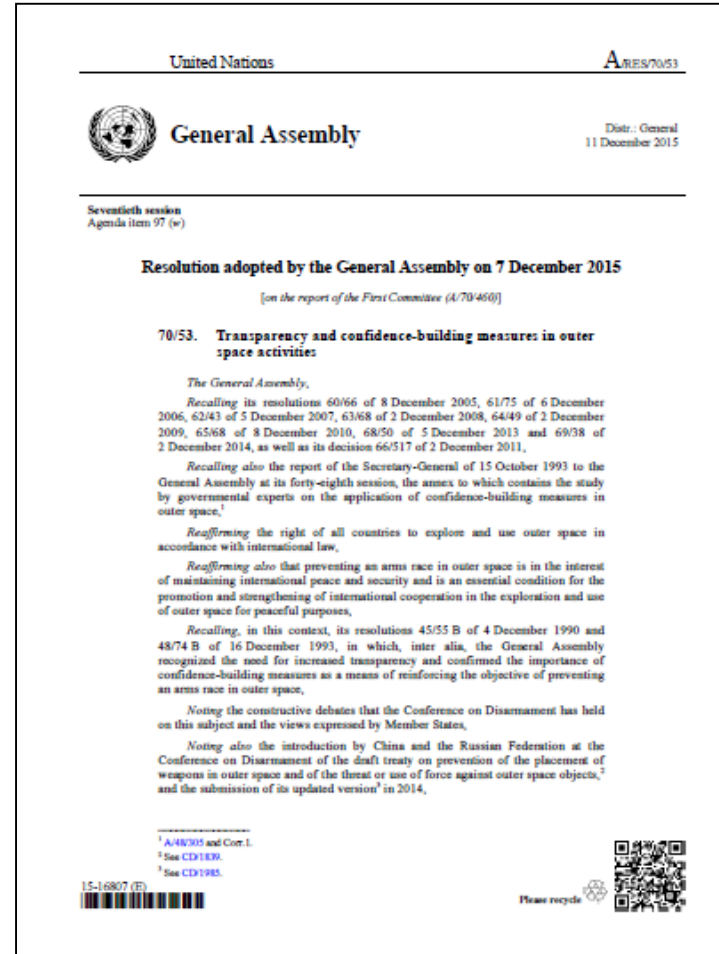

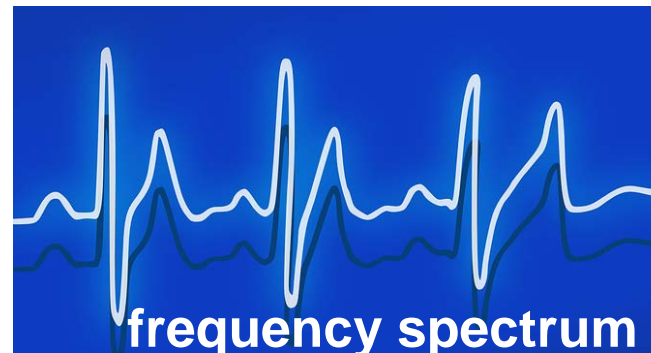

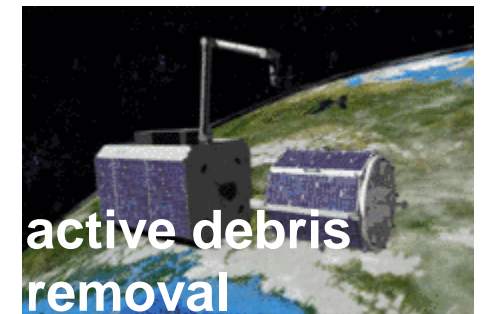

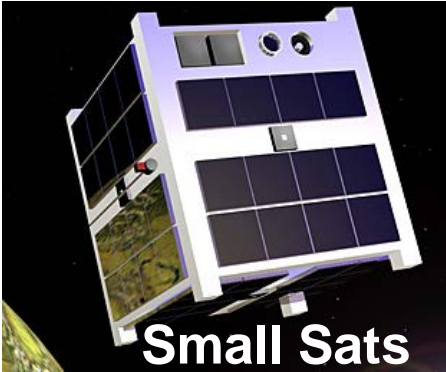
