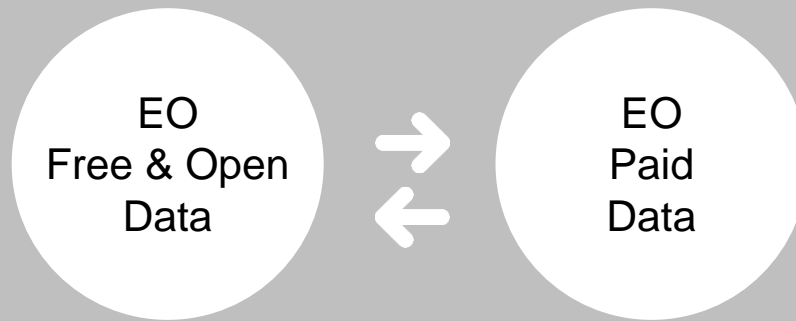

End Users

It should be stressed the message that End Users, will not receive operational EO services from European Institutions, but from industry.

Industry should lead the supply of EO Services

Taking the responsibility and risk of delivering Copernicus' born Services, accessing and developing new markets.

Industry to continue investing in new EO Product and Services

Needs a clear definition of boundaries between Public Sector and Private actors/players.
